

Introduction:

Do you have a special program that you would like to link with the SMS service? connectsaudi.com for mobile messages provides you with SMS Gateway service, or what is known as SMS API, through which you can easily Ease of linking the SMS text messaging service with your program, site or system, regardless of the programming language used in it. gates Our transmission has many advantages of SMS messages, which are safe and highly reliable, and you can connect them with your system through Your team of programmers, according to your data and specifications... These portals are links that you can communicate with through protocols HTTP/HTTPS Direct.

Before starting!

1. It is important to know some programming, before starting to deal with the transmission portals.
2. connectsaudi.com offers a number of free messages when opening a new account, in order to reduce the costs of the examination process.
3. When sending, the numbers to be sent must be written in international format without zeros and without the (+) symbol.
4. You can specify a sender name for your messages, and it must be an ID from Mobishatra.com” and the method will be explained

Activate the sender's name.

As a name sent later, the name of the sender must consist of letters (in English only and without special symbols) and its length should not exceed 11 if the name of the sender is composed of both letters and numbers

Features of connectsaudi.com SMS API:

Connecting to the connectsaudi.com portal is easy and simple, and it can be done through HTML Forms so that the data is sent in the form of POST, or you can send the data directly to the API URL through a Query String so that it is sent as a GET. If necessary To send a large amount of data we recommend using the first method POST, because the second method GET does not support sending large data.

A note about the sender's name: As we mentioned previously, it must be sent using an identified sender's name, and the case must be adhered to in terms of Lowercase or Uppercase, that is, as the sender's name has been defined.

Let's start:

In order to use the connectsaudi.com posting portals on our website first, as explained below, you must have your own account

Know your current balance:

You can know your balance directly by logging into your account on the site, and then go to the sending page where the balance is displayed at the top of the page. You can also know your balance through the balance portal and it will be clarified later

Note: Points are deducted based on the length of the messages sent, and the length of the message is calculated as follows:

- a. Messages in English: the length of the message is 160, and if a connected message is sent in English with a length of more than 160 characters, the length of the first message is 153 characters and the second is 153 characters, and so on
- b. Messages in Arabic: The length of the message is 70 If a connected message is sent in Arabic with a length of 70 characters, the length of the first message is 67 characters, the second is 67 characters, and so on...

Using the apiKey instead of the account information/Password:

Using the apiKey instead of the account information (password).

The apiKey: It has a special value in the user account website and it is generated in connectsaudi.com, and you can use the apiKey instead of the information (password), because it provides a more secure communication API.

You can get the apiKey on the website, by contacting your account manager on your connectsaudi.com

Parameters Definitions

SMS Template: Hi (1), your subscription will ends on (2). To send a Formatted SMS to a group of mobiles numbers, each number's variables must be defined, those variables will replacing (1) & (2), in the SMS that will be sent to the each mobile number, and you can include those variables, in the parameter: msgKey, like this:

msgKey = (1) , * , Akash ,@, (2) , * , name2 ***

(1), (2)...: the symbols where the values will be replaced with it.

*: separate between the symbol and the value that will replace it.

@: separate between each definition of the symbol and its value.

***: separate between each SMS definition.

Example: SMS Template: Hi (1), your subscription will end on (2).

msgKey: (1) , * , Akash ,@, (2) , * , 31/12/2013 * (1) , * ,Hitesh , @, (2) , *01/11/2023** Mobiles numbers: the count of mobiles numbers must equal the count of messages in the msgKey, so we will use two mobiles numbers in this example, they are: +9665012345 & +9665556789.

The SMSs that will be sent, according to our example are: SMS to +9665012345 will be: Hi Akash, your subscription will end on 31/12/2023. SMS to +9665556789 will be: Hi Hitesh, your subscription will end on 01/11/2023.
